Synagogue Preaching in Ephesus

Acts 19:8 (NASB)

And he entered the synagogue and continued speaking out boldly for three months, reasoning and persuading them about the kingdom of God.

- This picks up previous themes: synagogue ministry, boldness, reasoning
- The kingdom (see Acts 1:1-8; 8:12; 14:22; 20:25; 28:23; 28:31) plus this passage

Review: Synagogue Reasoning

Acts 17:2, 3 (NASB)

And according to Paul's custom, he went to them, and for three Sabbaths reasoned with them from the Scriptures, explaining and giving evidence that the Christ had to suffer and rise again from the dead, and saying, "This Jesus whom I am proclaiming to you is the Christ."

- This was the synagogue in Thessalonica (vs 1)
- There, some were persuaded (see vs 4)
- Some were hostile (vss 5-8)

But when some were becoming hardened and disobedient, speaking evil of the Way before the people, he withdrew from them and took away the disciples, reasoning daily in the school of Tyrannus.

- Those who reject the truth are hardened
- Some become disciples and learn and grow
- "The Way" is first mentioned in Acts 9:2
- "Reasoning" is *dialegomai* used 10X in Acts starting in 17:2 (of 13 total in NT)

Review: Public Debate

Acts 17:17, 18 (NASB)

So he was reasoning in the synagogue with the Jews and the God-fearing Gentiles, and in the market place every day with those who happened to be present. And also some of the Epicurean and Stoic philosophers were conversing with him. Some were saying, "What would this idle babbler wish to say?" Others, "He seems to be a proclaimer of strange deities,"—because he was preaching Jesus and the resurrection.

• "Reasoning" is the same word (here in Athens)

Acts 19:10 (NASB)

This took place for two years, so that all who lived in Asia heard the word of the Lord, both Jews and Greeks.

- Luke refers to the Roman province of Asia
- Ephesus is first mentioned in Acts 18:19 and is also found in chapters 19 and 20
