

GOSPEL LESSON

¹² "So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets. ¹³ "Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. ¹⁴ For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few. ¹⁵ "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. ¹⁶ You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? ¹⁷ So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. ¹⁸ A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. ¹⁹ Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. ²⁰ Thus you will recognize them by their fruits.

¹⁴ What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? ¹⁵ If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, ¹⁶ and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that? ¹⁷ So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. ¹⁸ But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." New COVID Protocol Starting March 28, 2021

Friends and members of Church Creek,

The elders together with the deacons recently met and discussed the encouraging signs that we see in our battle against the COVID pandemic. The number of cases continue to decline here in the Charleston area and the number of people being vaccinated is rising. We still believe there needs to be a vigilant attitude against carelessness and unnecessary exposure to the virus. Yet, we believe that we're at the point where more people are staying away from our corporate gatherings because of our mask requirement than those refraining from coming due to the very real risk of exposure.

The officers agreed together to the following new policy, effective Sunday, March 28, 2021.

- 1. Wearing masks will be optional at Sunday morning worship while in your pew on the main floor of the sanctuary. You are free to sit, stand and sing without a mask while in your pew during the entire length of the service.
- 2. Masks will continue to be required in the balcony and in the Fellowship Hall. Please choose these areas during worship if you want this added layer of protection.
- 3. Masks will be required when entering and leaving the sanctuary and when walking up and down the aisles, including bringing your offering up front and going to receive the elements for the Lord's Supper.
- 4. There is no mask requirement when outside of any of the buildings.

One additional note: Our adult Sunday School hour will resume on Sunday, April 11, and will be held in the sanctuary. Details to follow. We have decided not to resume the evening service at this time, but are looking at specific ideas about some kind of fellowship meal or picnic to be held on a regular basis.
