## FURTHER CONSIDERATIONS

### **Ephesians 2:4-7**

What words in these verses highlight the goodness of God? How does the description of your life without Christ, in Ephesians 2:1-4, emphasize the mercy of God? How do people tend to view the God of the Old Testament? Why? What is the reoccurring theme in these verses: Genesis 19:18; Exodus 34:6; Nehemiah 9:17; Psalm 37:26; Jonah 4:2? Why do people struggle to see God's mercy that is so prevalent in the Old Testament.

### **Ephesians 2:17-24**

What are the characteristics of the unsaved that are mentioned in these verses? How should spiritual birth demonstrate itself? Why would it be inappropriate to continue in the former way of living? Why might a person not be willing to change and grow?

### **Luke 7:11-17; Luke 8:49-56; John 11:41-46**

What does Jesus do in each of these stories? How does He do it? How are these physical resurrections a picture of spiritual resurrection? (See also John 5:24; Romans 10:17; 1 Peter 1:23.) How do these verses inform us and encourage us regarding how we should witness? Are you developing in your familiarity of Scripture so that you can share the life-giving Word? Will you pray that the Lord will provide a divine appointment for you to share the Word of Life?
