Introduction:

- 1. On September 11, 2001:
 - When 19 Terrorists:
 - Hijacked 4 Planes & Used Them As Weapons:
 - They Killed Nearly 3,000 People!
 - And Then The People Of America:
 - United Together To Defeat Those Enemies:
 - And Swore To:
 - Never Forget!
 - Well That Was:
 - Almost 20 Years Ago! And Will Be This Year!
 - And What Has Happened:
 - To That Unity?
 - What Has Happened:
 - To That Resolve?
 - Have We Forgotten?
 - And So Soon?
- 2. On December 7, 1941:
 - When The Empire Of Japan:
 - Launched A Surprise Attack On The US Navy Base:
 - At Pearl Harbor, Hawaii:
 - They Killed More Than 2,000 Sailors!
 - And Then The People Of America:
 - United Together To Defeat That Enemy:
 - And Swore They Would:
 - Never Forget!
 - Well That Was:
 - Almost 80 Years Ago! And Will Be This Year!
 - But Again What Happened:
 - To That Unity?
 - What Happened:
 - To That Resolve?
 - Did It Only Take 80 Years:
 - For So Many To Forget:
 - That History?
- 3. I'm Sure Many More Dates In History:
 - Can Be Added To These!
 - Not Just For Our Country:
 - But In Every Country:
 - Throughout The World!
 - A Tragic Event That:
 - Causes People To Unify & Resolve:
 - To "Never Forget!"
 - But How Much Time Does It Take:
 - For Those Things To Become All But Forgotten?
- 4. Well As We Turn Back In Our Bibles:
 - To Romans 9 I'm Sure That:
 - That Was One Of The Questions:
 - The Apostle Paul Was Dealing With As Well!
 - But Instead Of Man:
 - Who Can Forget Things:
 - So Quickly & So Easily!

- The Concern Was:
 - About God!
 - Because As We Saw From:

- 9:3 So Many People Of Israel:
 - Were As Paul Described Them:
 - "Accursed From Christ!"

- What Does That Say:
 - About God? About Their God?
 - So All Throughout This Chapter:
 - Paul Deals With Some Hard Questions:
 - About The Character & Nature Of God!
- 5. Now Some Of These Questions:
 - May Have Come From:
 - Honest Hearts! But Others Likely Came From:
 - Hard Hearts!
 - Because Instead Of Questions:
 - They Turned Into Accusations!
- 6. And So The First Question:
 - We Come To In 9:6-13 Is This:
 - Is God Faithful?
 - Since So Many Of God's Chosen People:
 - The People Of Israel:
 - Did Not Believe In Christ, And Therefore, Are "Accursed From Christ":
 - Is God Still Faithful?
 - To His People & To His Promises?
 - The Answer To This Question Is:
 - Yes! God Is Forever Faithful!
 - Because His Promises To Save:
 - Were Never Based Upon:
 - His People's Relationships:
 - With Man, But With Him!
 - His Promises To Save Were Not Made:
 - To A National Or A Natural Israel:
 - But Were Made To:
 - A Spiritual Israel!
 - And So According To 9:6:
 - God's Word Has Taken Effect!
 - But For A Spiritual Israel!
 - Because "They Are Not All Israel, Which Are Of Israel!"
 - Well This Answer Led Paul To:
- 7. A Second Question:
 - Which We Come To In 9:14-18:
 - Is God Fair?
 - Is It Fair For God:
 - To Chose Some Sinners To Save:
 - And At The Same Time:
 - Pass Over Others?
 - And The Answer To This Question Is:
 - Yes! God Is Fair Because God Is Just!
 - And His Justice Would Be Served:
 - If He Didn't Save Anyone!
 - But God Is Also Merciful!
 - As We See In 9:18 "Therefore hath he mercy on whom he will have mercy, and whom he will he hardeneth!"
 - Well This Answer Led Paul To:
- 8. A Third Question:
 - Which We Find In 9:19-24 Which We Looked At Last Week:
 - Is God At Fault?
 - If God Chooses To Save:
 - Whomsoever He Will:
 - Then How Can He Find Fault:

- With My Will?
- And The Answer To This Question Is:
 - No! God Is Not At Fault!
 - God Is Not The One To Be Blamed:
 - For Your Sin & Your Rebellion:
 - And Your Ultimate Punishment From Him!
 - Because Even Though:
 - God Is Sovereign Even In Salvation:
 - You Are Still Responsible:
 - For Your Attitude & Actions Against Him!
 - As We Saw From 9:21:
 - He Is Still The Potter & You Are Still The Clay!
 - So The Apostle Paul Puts A Stop To This Kind Of Questioning In 9:20:
 - "Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God?"
 - Well I Think This Question Led Paul Further To:
- 9. A Fourth Question:
 - Which Though It Is Not Specifically Mentioned:
 - Is Dealt With In The Verses We Come To This Morning:
 - 9:25-29 And That Ouestion Is;
 - Has God Forgotten?
 - He Himself Said He Would:
 - Never Forget!
 - But Has He?

- Has God Forgotten:
 - About His People And:
 - About His Plans For Them?
 - Has He Forgotten:
 - All Of The Prophecies He Made:
 - About Them?
- And This Is A Special Concern:
 - Because Of What Paul Wrote In 9:24:
 - About The People Of God Including:
 - Both Jews & Gentiles!
 - "Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?
- Well The Answer To This Question Is:
 - No! God Has Not Forgotten!
 - Because He Cannot Forget!
 - Instead He Has ${\it Fulfilled}$:
 - His Plans *And* His Prophecies:
 - For All Of His People!
- 10. And Paul Uses Several Prophetic Statements:
 - From The Old Testament:
 - To Prove That God Has *Not* Forgotten:
 - His Plans For His People!
 - And So Starting With Some Prophecies From Hosea:
 - 9:25-29 "As he saith also in Osee, I will call them my people, which were not my people; and her beloved, which was not beloved. / 26 And it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people; there shall they be called the children of the living God. / 27 Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved: / 28 For he will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth. / 29 And as Esaias said before, Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha!"
- 11. So Starting With A Couple Of Prophecies From Hosea:
 - Paul Wants Us To See That:
 - God Has Not Forgotten:
- 1. His True People!
 - In The Old Testament Book Of Hosea:

- There Are Prophecies About:
 - Who Is Included:
 - As The People Of God!
- They Are Both Jews & Gentiles:
 - And Are Chosen By Him:
 - To Be Vessels Of His Mercy And:
 - Trophies Of His Grace!
- Those "Whom He Hath Called" From 9:24:
 - Is Not Exclusive:
 - To One Particular Group / Nationality!
- Instead The True People Of God:
 - No Matter What Their Pedigree & Past:
 - Are Those Who:
- Belong To Him!
 - As Paul Quotes From Hosea 2:23:
 - In 9:25a "I Will Call Them My People, Which Were Not My People!"
 - When God Called Hosea:
 - To Be His Prophet:
 - He Asked Him To Love:
 - A Very Unfaithful Woman!
 - And Through That Relationship And:
 - Through His Family:
 - God Would Speak To His People!
 - So Several Children Were Born:
 - To Hosea & His Wife!
 - And The Name Given To One Son Was:
 - Loammi Which Meant:
 - "Not My People!" (1:9)
 - So Through Isaiah:
 - God Was Telling The Northern Kingdom Of Israel:
 - That They Were *No Longer*:
 - His People Because They Had Broken His Covenant, Time After Time After Time!
 - So In A Sense At This Time They Became To God:
 - As Gentile Nations! But Then Through Hosea:
 - He Promises To, Once Again, Show Great Mercy! How?
 - By Calling "Them My People, Which Were Not My People!"
 - And Paul Applies This:
 - To People From Any Nation & Background!
 - You Can Be Part Of:
 - The True People Of God!
 - And Then You Will Also Be:

- Beloved By Him!
 - As Paul Continues To Quote From Hosea 2:23:
 - In 9:25b "And her beloved, which was not beloved!"
 - Another One Of Hosea's Children:
 - His Daughter Was Given The Name:
 - Loruhamah Which Meant:
 - "No More Mercy!" (1:6)
 - But Then Through Hosea:
 - God Promises To, Once Again, Show His Great Love! How?
 - By Calling Them "Beloved, Which Was Not Beloved!"
 - And This Too Is Applied:
 - Not Just To The People Of Israel:
 - But To Everyone He Adopts:
 - Into His Family!
 - And What Love Is This!
 - **IE:** Just Like In Adoption:

- Its Not Just A Special Affection:
 - It Is A Special Selection!
- Because When A Family Adopts A Baby:
 - They Know Little To Nothing:
 - About That Child!
- But Think About All That God **Does** Know:
 - About Those He Adopts Into His Family!
 - He Knows All That You Are, All That You'd Do, And All That You'd Be!
- And Still He Chose You:
 - If You Are His Child Today!
 - But What's More The True People Of God Are:
- Begotten By Him!
 - As Paul Then Quotes From Hosea 1:10:
 - In 9:26 "And it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people; there shall they be called the children of the living God!"
 - Not Just Where Hosea Prophesied Against:
 - The Nation Of Israel But:
 - In Every Nation Where:
 - They Were "Not God's People!"
 - What Happens To Them?
 - "There Shall They Be Called The Children Of The Living God!"
- What An Amazing Truth:
 - That The Apostle Paul Is Bringing Out:
 - From These Verses In Hosea!
 - God Has Never Forgotten:
 - His True People!
 - And He Never Will!
 - And So What Matters:
 - Is *Not* Your Earthly Heritage Or:
 - Your National Home!
 - What Matters Is:
 - Your Heavenly Heritage And:
 - Your Heavenly Home!
 - Do You Belong To The Lord?
 - Are You One Of His Beloved?
 - Have You Been Begotten Into His Family?
 - How Can You Know?
 - In John 1:12 As John Tells Us Of Jesus:
 - He Says "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name!"
 - When You Believe In Jesus Christ As Your Savior From Sin:
 - You Become Part Of His Family!
 - You Are One Of His "True People!"
 - And The Prophecies In Hosea Were Prophecies About You!
 - And God Has Never Forgotten:
 - His Plan & Purpose For You!
- * But Then Paul Also Wants Us To See That God Has Not Forgotten:
- 2. His True Promise!
 - His True Promise To His True People!
 - And So Paul Looks Back To:
 - The Prophet Isaiah:
 - And In 9:27-28 Refers To & Quotes From Isaiah 10:22-23!
 - "Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved: / For he will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth!"
 - $\hbox{- Some English Versions Do Not Have The Whole Quote But The Meaning Remains The Same!}\\$
 - God Has Not Forgotten:

- The Promise Of A Remnant!
 - There's An Interesting Connection:
 - Between This Quote From Isaiah & The Previous Quote From Hosea!
 - Back In Hosea 1:10 It Also Describes The Children Of Israel As Being "As The Sand Of The Sea!"
 - Perhaps As Paul Was Thinking About The Verse In Hosea God Brought The Verse In Isaiah To His Mind:
 - "Though The Number Of The Children Of Israel Be As The Sand Of The Sea!"
 - But The Point Paul Is Making Here:
 - Is That God's Earthly Blessing:
 - Is *Not* The Same Thing As:
 - His Heavenly Blessing!
 - Because There's:
 - The Sand Which Refers To:
 - The Nation Of Israel!
 - And Then There's:
 - The Saved The Remnant!
 - Which Of These Two:
 - Matter Most?
 - The Remnant! To Be Saved!
 - So Not All Of The "Sand Of The Sea" According To The Lord's Word Given Through Isaiah:
 - Will Be Saved But Only:
 - A Select Handful Picked Up By The Hand Of God!
 - **IE:** Just Like When You May Go To The Beach Lot's Of Sand The Destructive Waves Keep Crashing Against It But You Or Your Children Pick A Section Of The Beach To Build Your Sand-Castle! This Is What God Does!
 - He Promises That From All The Sand Along The Sea There Will Be A Remnant That He Saves!
 - And That Remnant Are Those Who Believe In & Belong To Jesus Christ!
 - God Has Not Forgotten:
 - His Promise Of A Remnant!
 - This Truth Encouraged Elijah:
 - As We Will See Later In Romans!
 - But At A Time When He Felt All Alone:
 - God Said To Him 1 Kings 19:18 "Yet I have left me seven thousand in Israel, all the knees which have not bowed unto Baal, and every mouth which hath not kissed him!"
 - But God Also Has Not Forgotten:
- The Promise Of His Righteousness!
 - Because Of His Holy & Righteous Nature:
 - God Must Still Judge The Sins Of The Sand!
 - So Even Though A "Remnant Shall Be Saved" Yet:
 - 9:28 "He Will" And He Must "Finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth!"
 - The "Work" Here Is God's "Word" Of Judgment For Sin! His Sentence Upon Sinners:
 - As The "Judge Of All The Earth!"
 - And Here God Says:
 - That His Judgment:
 - Will Be Both Sure & Swift!
 - He Will Complete It And:
 - He Will Do So By Cutting It Short!
 - It Doesn't Take God Long:
 - To Bring His Judgment:
 - Upon The Earth!
 - Just Look At The Book Of Revelation! Seal After Seal! Trumpet After Trumpet! Bowl After Bowl Of God's Wrath!
 - And This Too Is One Of God's Promises!
- And So God Has Never Forgotten:
 - His True Promises!

- The Promise Of His Righteousness:
 - Is The Basis Of His Judgment! But:
- The Promise Of A Remnant:
 - Is A Promise To Even:
 - "In Wrath, Remember Mercy!" (Habakkuk 3:2)
- And His Mercy:
 - Is Found In The Lord Jesus Christ!
- * But Then Paul Further Wants Us To Know That God Has Not Forgotten:
- 3. His True Provision!
 - His True Provision Of A Seed!
 - So Paul Looks Back To Another Prophecy:
 - Given To Isaiah:
 - In Isaiah 1:9 Which Paul Refers To:
 - In 9:29 "And as Esaias said before, Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha!"
 - The Verb Translated "Had Left" In This Verse:
 - Is Related To The Word Translated:
 - "Remnant" In 9:27 So The Seed Of God Is The Remnant He Saves!
 - So He's Not Talking About:
 - The Seed Of:
 - Abraham & Isaac & Jacob:
 - In This Verse!
 - He's Talking About:
 - A Spiritual Seed!
 - And His Own Provision:
 - Of This Seed!
 - God Is Able To Provide & Leave A Seed:
 - Because Of His Great Power!
 - He Is "The Lord Of Sabaoth!"
 - The "Lord Of Hosts!"
 - As The Omnipotent & Sovereign God:
 - He Is Able To Do:
 - What Seems To Be Impossible!
 - He Is Able To "Leave Us A Seed!"
 - Which Is Necessary:
 - Because Of Our Great Poverty!
 - The Truth Is:
 - Without God's Intervention:
 - Noone Could Be Saved And:
 - No Seed Would Have Been Left!
 - Isaiah Points Out That:
 - If God Didn't Provide:
 - A Seed & A Remnant:
 - "We Had Been As Sodom, And Been Made Like Unto Gomorrha!"
 - This May Mean That:
 - Apart From God's Intervention:
 - We Would All:
 - Have Been As Wicked:
 - As The Citizens Of Sodom!
 - Who Were Known For:
 - Their Unspeakable Sins & Crimes Against God!
 - Isaiah Even Describes Our Sinful Condition In Isaiah 1:6:
 - "From the sole of the foot even unto the head there is no soundness in it; but wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores!"
 - And Then:
 - Apart From God's Intervention:
 - We Would All:

- Have Been Destroyed:
 - As The City Of Gomorrha!
- When In Genesis 19:24:
 - "The LORD rained upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven!"
- And Yet What Did God Choose To Do:
 - Even Back Then? He Preserved A Seed!
 - He Sent His Angels Into The Wicked City Of Sodom To Rescue Lot And His Family:
 - By Grabbing Their Hands & Pulling Them Out!
 - And This Is What God Does:
 - To You & To Me Through Jesus Christ:
 - Even While We Are Wallowing In The Depths Of Our Own Depravity!
 - He Provides Salvation:
 - And Leaves A Seed!
 - **IE:** Have You Heard Of The "Global Seed Vault"? It Is An 11,000 Square Foot Warehouse Carved Into A Mountain In Norway! It Is Where Seeds Can Be Preserved In Case Of World-Wide Catastrophe! Currently, There Are Over 400,000 Seed Samples In The Vault!
- This Is What God Has Done For Himself!
 - He Has Preserved For Himself:
 - A Seed From The Mass Of:
 - Sinful Humanity!
 - If He Didn't Do This:
 - We Would All Be Lost And Judged:
 - For All Of Eternity!
 - But Because Of His Mercy & Grace:
 - He Sent Jesus Christ:
 - To Be The Vault:
 - Of The Human Seeds:
 - Who Turn To & Trust In Him For Salvation From Their Sins!
 - Even As Jesus Himself Said:
 - In John 10:28-29 "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. / My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand!"
 - And God Has Never Forgotten:
 - His True Provision! And He Never Will!

Conclusion:

- 1. We Forget Things:
 - So Easily & So Quickly Sometimes!
 - But God Doesn't! God Can't!
- 2. These Prophecies From The Old Testament:
 - Prove That:
 - God Has Not & Will Not Ever:
 - Forget His Plans:
 - For His People!
 - Instead He Will:
 - Fulfill Them All! And You Can Rest In His Promises!

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
