Ecclesiastes 11:7 - 12:8

- I. <u>ENJOY YOUR LIFE</u> (11:7-10; Ps 56:13)
 - A. Sweetness and Light (7)—the good pleasures of this life
 - B. However many years you live (7-8a)—enjoy all of them
 - 1. You don't know how many.
 - 2. Each has something to enjoy.
 - **C. Enjoy Your Youth** (9-10; Pr 20:29)
 - **1. Follow Your Heart**—what makes you happy
 - **2. See the World**—go places, have adventures
 - **3. Don't Worry**—live now, not in dread of the future
- II. <u>BUT REMEMBER</u>—keep a balanced view of life
 - A. <u>Days of Darkness</u> (11:8b)—hard times
 - 1. Management of Expectations (Jn 16:33; 1 Pet 4:12)
 - 2. Types of Darkness (2 Cor 7:5)
 - a. Inside and Outside of Us
 - b. General and Personal
 - c. Physical, Emotional, Spiritual
 - **3. Treasures of Darkness** (Isa 45:3, 7)—God uses to grow and enrich us
 - B. God's Judgment (11:9c)
 - **1. Omniscient** (1 Cor 14:25; Heb 4:13; 2 Pet 3:10)—knows everything.
 - **2. Comprehensive** (Ps 25:7; Job 13:26; 2 Tim 2:22)—whole life
 - **3. Personal** (Ps 139; Jer 32:19; Rev 20:12-13)—responsible for *our own* lives, *our own* actions.

- **C.** <u>Your Creator</u> (12:1-6)
 - 1. In Your Youth (Ps 119:9)—while you are still young
 - a. So you don't ruin your life—poor choices
 - b. So you don't waste your life—unsatisfying, won't last
 - 2. Before Days of Trouble—poetic description of decline of old age
 - 3. Before Loss of Pleasure
 - **a.** The Years of Old Age—what do you have without God?
 - **b.** The Memory of Your Youth—joy or regret?
 - c. The Passing of Worldly Pleasures—they are fleeting.
 - 4. Before Your Death (Heb 9:27)—last chance to get right with God
- **III.** WHEN YOU DIE (12:5-7)—What happens to us at death?
 - **A.** <u>Dust Returns to the Ground</u> (Ps 90:3; 104:29; Job 10:9)—physical body dies and decays
 - B. Spirit Returns to God
 - 1. He gave it. (Gen 2:7)—God is the Source, Creator
 - 2. He will take it back. (Lk 12:20)—belongs to Him, entrusted to you
 - **3.** He will judge it. (Mat 10:28; 12:36; Rom 14:12; 1 Pet 4:5)—what you did with the life He gave you
 - **C.** Our Eternal Home (5)—the place we will spend eternity
- IV. <u>Vanity, Vanity, All Is Vanity</u> (11:8, 10; 12:8)—
 - A. A Lament—broken world, brief life under the sun
 - B. The Cry for a Savior

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
