⁸ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: ¹⁰ But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: ¹¹ For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

¹² Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

THE COMMUNION IN GLORY WITH CHRIST, WHICH THE MEMBERS OF THE INVISIBLE CHURCH ENJOY IMMEDIATELY AFTER DEATH, IS, IN THAT THEIR SOULS ARE THEN MADE PERFECT IN HOLINESS,^A AND RECEIVED INTO THE HIGHEST HEAVENS,^B WHERE THEY BEHOLD THE FACE OF GOD IN LIGHT AND GLORY,^C WAITING FOR THE FULL REDEMPTION OF THEIR BODIES,^D WHICH EVEN IN DEATH CONTINUE UNITED TO CHRIST,^E AND REST IN THEIR GRAVES AS IN THEIR BEDS,^F TILL AT THE LAST DAY THEY BE AGAIN UNITED TO THEIR SOULS.^G WHEREAS THE SOULS OF THE WICKED ARE AT THEIR DEATH CAST INTO HELL, WHERE THEY REMAIN IN TORMENTS AND UTTER DARKNESS, AND THEIR BODIES KEPT IN THEIR GRAVES, AS IN THEIR PRISONS, TILL THE RESURRECTION AND JUDGMENT OF THE GREAT DAY.^H
