Damning reactions to Christ manifested during His unjust Trials, from The Gospel of Mark 15:1-15, part 1

Introduction:

John 14:6 Jesus said ... "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Acts 4:12 "there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again

John 3:3b... unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

#5 Christ is mocked before **Herod** at 7am in Luke 23

#6 Christ is tried before **Pilate** and **the mob** around 8am in Mark 15
