TEXT: Ecclesiastes 9:1-10:20 (ESV)

INTRODUCTION

Death, more than anything else, reminds us of the <u>futility</u> of life.

Psalm 90:10

[10] The years of our life are seventy, or even by reason of strength eighty; yet their span is but toil and trouble; they are soon gone, and we fly away.

Psalm 103:15

[15] As for man, his days are like grass; he flourishes like a flower of the field;

Since death comes to all, let us live our days with great <u>purpose</u>.

THE INEVITABILITY OF DEATH

Whether a person is filled with <u>vices</u> or <u>virtues</u>, they still cannot avoid the reality of death.

Death is the great enemy.

1 Corinthians 15:25–26–[25] For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. [26] The last enemy to be destroyed is death.

Romans 5:12–[12] Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned...

Revelation 20:14—[14] Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire.

THE NECESSITY OF JOY

Ecclesiastes is a realistic book that points us to joy.

Ecclesiastes 8:15–[15] And I commend joy, for man has nothing better under the sun but to eat and drink and be joyful...

We are to take joy in the things the Lord provides.

We are to take joy in the <u>relationships</u> the Lord provides.

THE NECESSITY OF WISDOM

I want you to understand why death makes wisdom <u>urgent</u>.

Proverbs 8:35–36

[35] For whoever finds me [wisdom] finds life and obtains favor from the LORD,[36] but he who fails to find me injures himself; all who hate me love death."

Wisdom is powerful even when unnoticed.

Wisdom comes from the <u>humble</u>, so do not be impressed with the mighty.

Proverbs 11:2

[2] When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with the humble is wisdom.

James 3:13–[13] Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom.

Ephesians 3:10–...through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.

Folly is a disease.

Folly, ultimately, is a matter of the heart.

Proverbs 4:23

[23] Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life.
