Luke 17:11-37

- I. The Story of the Healed Lepers (11-19)
 - A. Ten lepers were calling out to be healed
 - B. Jesus healed them all and called for them to follow the pattern of worship and obedience
 - C. It was the foreigner, the one unaccepted even if he didn't have leprosy, that came back and glorified God
- II. The Second Coming (20-32)
 - A. The days are coming (not here yet)
 - B. The coming of the Son will be sudden and expansively felt
 - C. The crucifixion must take place first
 - D. Consider the circumstances: for most it was "business as usual"
 - E. When the end comes, don't be caught looking back
- III. Who Is Saved and Who Is Judged? (33-37)
 - A. If you seek to save your life, you will lose it
 - B. Two in one bed, two at one work, two in one field
 - C. Those taken are delivered, those that remain are where the vultures gather.
