DAILY READINGS, LEVITICUS

I suggest you skim through this book, letting the questions guide you, about 6-7 questions per day. Chapters that contain the most “readable” material are 9,10, 19,26, and 27. The others are quite legal in tone, and can be very difficult. If you decide to read the entire book, you will need to cover about 4 chapters a day.

INTRO, LEVITICUS

The title indicates that the matters discussed pertain to the Levites (more specifically, the priests of Levi) . This is the third book of Moses, set at the foot of Mt. Sinai. There is no movement of the Israelites from city to city in this book. The outline is simply: Sacrifice -approaching God (1-17) and Sanctification -walk with God (18-27).

The date is 1445 B.C., the giving of the law. In 1405 BC, perhaps, the book was finished by Moses. Internal dating is “First month of the 2nd year” (dated from Passover).

The Christ of Leviticus is in the 5 offerings (burnt, meal, peace, sin, trespass), the High Priest, and the seven feasts (Passover, unleavened bread, firstfruits, Pentecost, trumpets day of Atonement, tabernacles)
