I. DEFINING THE ISSUE FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING

Eternal Security: One who has been genuinely saved by God's grace through faith alone in Christ alone shall never be in danger of God's condemnation or loss of their salvation, but is kept forever saved by God's grace and power.
