**1. Paul and the mission team were moving westward through the Roman empire seeking to share the gospel with the Jews first and also the Greeks.**

- a. Paul had clear revelation from God that he was to bear the name of Christ “before the Gentiles and kings and the sons of Israel” (Acts 9:15). With biblical \_\_\_\_\_ he planned his ministry accordingly.
