

11 For the grace of God has appeared,

God's grace trains believers how to live in this present age.

bringing salvation for all people,

12 training us to renounce ← ungodliness

We live -- rejecting ungodliness

and worldly passions,

and to live self-controlled,

upright,

and godly lives in the present age,

We live -- embracing godliness

13 waiting for our blessed hope,

We live -- anticipating Christ's return

the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

14 who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness

and to purify for himself a people for his own possession

who are zealous for good works.

15 Declare these things;

exhort

and rebuke with all authority.

Let no one disregard you.

Note GNT - 'to renounce and 'to live' are not parallel thoughts. The primary thought is that God's grace trains us to live.... The manner in which we live is by renouncing..., self-controlled, upright, etc.

Note GNT -- these are not two parallel things which come from God's grace appearing -- bringing salvation and training us. 'Bringing salvation' is identifying the grace Paul is talking about.
