1) Basic Principles

- a) Sons of God are led by Spirit of God (v. 14)
- b) We will suffer in this present time (v. 17)

- e) God's greatest "good" & chief aim (v. 29)
- f) We respond to these truths in faith (v. 31)...

2) Replace Fear with Love

1 John 4:18, Rom 5:5, Eph 2:10, Matt 5:16, Galatians 6:10, 1 John 5:4

- a) Start thinking about others' needs
- b) Use your "outings" well

Phil 2:3-4 – We do nothing (actually) from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.

c) Obey Authorities

Rom 13:1, 1 Pet 2:13

d) Speak the truth in love

Psalm 15:2 – The tongue of the wise commends knowledge, but the mouths of fools pour out folly.

Col 3:1, Phil 4:6,8

- e) Like a Soldier, strategically Ignore Danger
 - 2 Tim 2:1,3
 - 1 John 5:5

"I shall ask God mercifully to protect us. Then I shall fumigate, help purify the air, administer medicine and take it. I shall avoid places and persons where my presence is not needed in order not to become contaminated and thus perchance inflict and pollute others and so cause their death as a result of my negligence. If God should wish to take me, he will surely find me and I have done what he has expected of me and so I am not responsible for either my own death or the death of others. However, if my neighbor needs me I shall not avoid place or person but will go freely as stated above. See this is such a God-fearing faith because it is neither brash nor foolhardy and does not tempt God."²
