
What does God look like?



God the Father

1. God the Father is not described in the Bible
2. God the Father gives the role of judge to the Son (John 5:22; 2 Corinthians 5:22)

“Ancient of Days” indicates
ageless, timeless, changeless
character.

#1: As the Ancient of Days Jesus is Unchanging

A. His judgements have always been the same



#2: As the Ancient of Days Jesus is Unchangeable



#2: As the Ancient of Days Jesus is Unchangeable

- A. Daniel has a vision of the “Ancient of Days” 500 years before Christ was born. This vision was very specific.
- B. John has a vision of the “Son of Man” *after* Jesus was on earth, died, and rose from the dead. John’s vision matches the specificity of Daniel’s vision exactly.

Before Jesus was born, He thought about being born.


