#### **Ephesians 2:8-9**

What are the elements of saving faith mentioned in verse 8? What does a person need to be saved from? What is grace? What is faith? How do these verses emphasize the character of God, expressed in verses 4-7?

#### Romans 10:1-4

How does Paul express his burden for his fellow Israelites? What were they attempting to do? How do people today seek to establish their own righteous standing before God? What are the key aspects that need to be clear when giving the Gospel to others?
