I Ascend to My Father (John 20:11-18, Acts 1:8-11)

Introduction: A summary of the events of Resurrection morning

Mary Magdalene sees the empty tomb Mary the mother of James and Salome see the angels John and Peter see the grave clothes Mary Magdalene sees Jesus

1. John 20:11-18: Mary Magdalene meets Jesus

Weeping, Mary encounters the angels (vs 11-13)

Application: Behind a frowning providence He hides a smiling face

Weeping, Mary encounters Jesus (vs 14-15)

Application 1: Do not miss the spiritual by looking only for the natural Application 2: Know how much you are forgiven so that you love much

Rejoicing, Mary clings to Jesus (vs 16-17a)

Application 1: Faith comes by hearing the word of Christ

Application 2: During trials, do not be anxious, Jesus is nearer than you think

Application 3: We now know Jesus by faith, not by sight (2 Co 5:16-17)

Commissioned, Mary shares the Gospel with Christ's brothers (vs 17b-18)

Application 1: The comfort of being a brother of Christ

Application 2: Have you seen Christ? Is He vivid in your mind's eye?

2. Acts 1:8-11: The Ascension of Jesus

Is the occasion of Christ's glorification
Is the occasion by which Christ is preparing a place for us
Shows us the glorious future of our glorified body
Enables Him to send the Holy Spirit to indwell and empower us
Enables Him to give gifts to the church
Begins His new intercessory work for the church
Anticipates His return in like manner
