⁴ Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of *any thing* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth: ⁵ Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me; ⁶ And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

QUESTION # 87: WHAT ARE WE TO BELIEVE CONCERNING THE RESURRECTION?

ANSWER:

WE ARE TO BELIEVE, THAT AT THE LAST DAY THERE SHALL BE A GENERAL RESURRECTION OF THE DEAD, BOTH OF THE JUST AND UNJUST:^A WHEN THEY THAT ARE THEN FOUND ALIVE SHALL IN A MOMENT BE CHANGED; AND THE SELF—SAME BODIES OF THE DEAD WHICH WERE LAID IN THE GRAVE, BEING THEN AGAIN UNITED TO THEIR SOULS FOR EVER, SHALL BE RAISED UP BY THE POWER OF CHRIST.^B THE BODIES OF THE JUST, BY THE SPIRIT OF CHRIST, AND BY VIRTUE OF HIS RESURRECTION AS THEIR HEAD, SHALL BE RAISED IN POWER, SPIRITUAL, INCORRUPTIBLE, AND MADE LIKE TO HIS GLORIOUS BODY;^C AND THE BODIES OF THE WICKED SHALL BE RAISED UP IN DISHONOUR BY HIM, AS AN OFFENDED JUDGE.^D
