MIRACULOUS DELIVERANCE FROM THE SYRIAN ARMY 2 Kings 7:1-20

- I. THE SIN OF UNBELIEF (2;)—the king's right hand man

 Not believing the word of the LORD, not trusting the character of God.
 - A. A Personal Hardness of Heart (Heb 3:12-13)—disrespect and contempt
 - B. The Responsibility of Leadership (Mat 23:13)
 - **1.** Public Position (1 Sam 2:30)—publicly undercut the Word of the Lord.
 - **2.** <u>Personal Influence</u> (Act 13:6-12)—the people in our spheres of influence
 - C. The Need for Holy Self-Awareness (Ps 73:15)
 - **1.** Aware of God—the Fear of God (God is real, relevant, present)
 - **2.** Aware of Others—of what they need and how we are affecting them
 - 3. Aware of Our Influence—for good or for evil, to encourage or to discourage
- II. THE POWER OF FEAR (6-7, 15)—the routing of the Syrian army
 Unreasonable versus reasonable
 - **A.** <u>Godly Fear</u> (Luke 12:5)—God is bigger, stronger, more real than anyone or anything else. Don't need to fear anything else!
 - **B.** <u>Ungodly Fear</u> (Lev 26:36; Prov 28:1)—comes from not knowing or being in right relationship with God
 - **1.** Fear of an <u>uneasy conscience</u> (1 Jn 4:18)—*discovery and judgment*

- **2. Fear of being <u>overpowered</u>** by enemies or <u>crushed</u> by the difficulties of life. (Ps 27:1-3, 5; 56:11)
- **3. Fear of** death (Prov 14:32; Heb 2:15)—without the assurance of resurrection and eternal life
- **C.** The Sound of God's Army (6)—impending judgment
 - 1. Causes mortal terror to the enemies of God
 - **2. Reveals the <u>worthlessness</u> of worldly things in the day of judgment** (Ps 49:16-17; Prov 11:4, 7; 13:22)
- III. THE BEARERS OF GOOD NEWS (3-11)—the lepers and social outcasts (us!)
 - A. Realistic Appraisal of the Situation (4)—nothing to lose, going to die anyway
 - **1.** Recognizing Our Misery—idols not delivering the joy and satisfaction
 - 2. Facing Our Mortality—we are all going to die!
 - **3. Considering Our** Prospects—the world has nothing to offer us
 - **B.** Acting in Humility (4; Isa 55:1-2; Jn 6:35, 37; Jas 4:6)—doing something about it; seeking mercy
 - **C.** <u>Compelled to Share</u> (9; Isa 40:1-2, 9)—evangelism, sharing the good news; one beggar telling another beggar where to find bread
 - 1. Concern for others (Gen 4:9; Phil 2:4)—social conscience
 - 2. Too good to keep to ourselves
