Need No Repentance, Pt. 1

Lk 5:31-32, Matt 7:13-14

Romans 2 is for two primary reasons: Witness and Self-Evaluation.

The Gospel is not good news <u>instead of</u> Judgment. The Gospel is good news <u>in light of</u> Judgment.

The Gospel does not <u>remove</u> Judgment, The Gospel simply <u>reassigns</u> Judgment... from the sinner to the Substitute.

5 characteristics of God's Judgment

1) God Judges Finally - v. 5, 16

John 5:28-29

- 2) God Judges Simply (based on Works) v. 1-3, 6-10, 13
 - Mt 5:20, 48
 - Mt 19:17
 - Jn 5:29

3) God Judges Impartially - v. 11

4) God Judges Comprehensively – v. 16

Isaiah 47:10-11

5) God Judges Mercifully - v. 4

God has no delight in the death of the wicked, but rather that he should turn from his ways and live. - Ezekiel 18

Praxis

- 1. What keeps people (you) from seeing the need for repentance? (be comprehensive)
- 2. What are some of the *kindnesses* (2:4) of God that lead you to repentance? How do you at times "think lightly" of them?
- 3. Paul clearly puts forward "works" in 2:5-12 as the basis for both judgment and eternal life (see also Mt 5:20,48,19:17, Jn 5:28-29). How do these statements fit with the Gospel of salvation by grace through faith?
- 4. How can we practically help our neighbors who think they need no repentance see their need of the Gospel? How might v. 12-16 help?
