REVIEW

- Even if we have been sinned against, our first focus is always on our own sins.
- We seek forgiveness from those whom we have sinned against as if we were trying to avoid "debtor's prison".
- The sins we commit are always indicative of greater sins in our heart.

STAGES IN THE PROCESS OF FORGIVING

- 1. Forgiveness toward all
- 2. Confrontation leading to repentance
- 3. Reconciliation
- 4. Restoration

BEING SINNED AGAINST

Q: In what ways do people sin against others? What sins would we classify as "sinning against" someone?

MARK 11:25

"And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses."

DEFINITION OF FORGIVE

- Greek verb is aphiemi-
 - lit. "to emit, send forth, send away"; or "to leave" (Mt. 4:11; Rev. 2:4).
 - metaph. of divorce (1Cor. 7:11); of dying ("giving up the spirit" - Mt. 27:50); to speak out loud (Mk. 15:37).
 - "to forgive" mostly in gospels; but also Acts 8:22; Rom. 4:7; 1John 2:12.

DEFINITION OF FORGIVE

- Forgiveness is a conscious decision to obey and imitate God by:
 - not holding onto animosity, malice, or bitterness;
 - resolving to fight against such in the future;
 - and determining to pray and (if possible)
 work for my enemy's spiritual good.

"LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON"

- Matthew 5:44-45 "But I say to you, 'Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven."
- Psalm 145:9 "The LORD is good to all, and His mercy is over all that He has made."
- Ephesians 4:32 "Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you."

"LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON"

- Luke 23:34 "And Jesus said, 'Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."
- Acts 7:60 "And falling to his knees [Stephen]
 cried out with a loud voice, 'Lord, do not hold
 this sin against them.' And when he had said
 this, he fell asleep."

DEFINITION OF FORGIVE

NEGATIVELY... What might be some types or indications of un-Biblical "forgiveness"?

APPLICATIONS

There is no room for bitterness in a Christian heart.

APPLICATIONS

- Forgiveness of others' sins against you is a necessary part of being a child of God. It is not optional.
- Failure to forgive is "un-God-like" and a sin.

APPLICATIONS

When combined with Matthew 5:21, the two parties ought to find themselves meeting each other.
