B. His Divinity

1. Son of God - Ps 2:7,12; Is 7:14; 9:6
 - a. *‘Immanuw’el* - with us (is) God; Immanuel, a type name of Isaiah's son.
 - b. Sinless - Ex 12:5; Le 22:18-21; 23:12; Ps 40:6-8; Is 53:6,9; Mal 1:8,14
 - c. Provided by God - Ge 22:7-8,14
 - d. will come out of Egypt - Ho 11:1
2. His Job as Son
 - a. A Prophet like Moses - De 18:15, 18
 - b. A Faithful Priest - 1 Sam 2:35; Ps 110:4; Zec 6:12-13
 - c. A King - Ge 49:10; 1 Sa 7:12-13; Ps 2:6; Zec 9:9
 - i. will have an eternal Kingdom - 2 Sam 7:12-13; Da 7:13-14
 - ii. Government on His shoulders - Is 9:6
3. His Job as Redeemer/ Messiah
 - a. Would begin His ministry in Galilee - Is 9:1-2
 - b. Would be humbled for Service - Ps 8:5-6
 - c. Would Preach Righteousness to Israel - Ps 40:9
 - d. Would Speak in Parables - Ps 78:1-2
 - e. Would Do Miracles - Is 35:4-6
 - f. Would draw Gentiles to Himself - Is 11:10; 42:1-4
 - g. Would cause some to stumble - Is 8:14
 - h. Would be celebrated as He arrived on a donkey - Zec 9:9
 - i. Would have a plot against Him to kill God’s anointed - Ps 31:13

- j. Would be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver - Zec 11:12-13
- k. Would be Silent before His accusers - Ps 38:12-13; Is 53:7
- l. Would be mocked and abused - Is 50:3-6
- m. Suffering would include pierced hands and feet - Ps 22:16
- n. Would be forsaken - Ps 22:1; 31:11; 41:9
- o. Would be Scorned - Ps 22:8
- p. Would not have any broken bones - Ex 12:46; Ps 34:20
- q. Would spill His blood for Atonement - Le 17:11
- r. Suffering would include thirst - Ps 22:15
- s. Thirst would be quenched with vinegar and gall - Ps 69:21
- t. Suffering would include the casting of lots for His clothing - Ps 22:18
- u. Would cry out "into your hands, I commit my Spirit" - Ps 31:5
- v. Would be raised from the dead - Job 19:23-27; Ps 16:10; 118:17-18
- w. Would conquer death - Is 25:7-8
- x. Would Bring and end to sin - Da 9:24
- y. Would Set captives free - Is 61:1
- z. Would Destroy the Devil's work - Ge 3:15
- aa. Would be Despised and rejected - Is 53:3
- bb. Would initiate the New Covenant - Jer 31:31
- cc. Would ascend into heaven and distribute gifts - Ps 68:18
- dd. Would pour out His Spirit - Is 44:3
- ee. Will judge the world in righteousness - Ps 9:7-10
