Why is the Apostle Paul so strange?

What motivates Paul to serve others?

The Fear of God v 11 and The Love of Christ v 14.

Can you say with passionate conviction that Jesus died for me?

One Died for All

At first, Paul thought Jesus a heretic, and that Christians needed rebuke.

What changed Paul's mind?

“Because we have concluded this: one has died for all.”

Paul died and was brought to new life instantly. A new creation.

This is how Jesus fixes what is wrong with the world - one heart at a time.

All Died

All believers share in Christ's death.

All men everywhere are commanded to repent and believe the gospel.

The sinful nature has died in the death of Christ. (Galatians 2:20)

We No Longer Live for Ourselves

The heart of stone is removed.

If someone does you a favor, you feel obligated to respond.

Galatians 2:20, Philippians 1:21, Philippians 3:8.

When you lose your life, you find it.
