

Why is the Battle Against Sin so Difficult? Romans 7:13 – 21 Part 1

- I. Is the “good” law (12) given by God (meant to bring about life v.10) actually a source of death (and thus it is actually “evil” or sinful?) (13)

- II. The Law—having come from the Spirit (“spiritual”) is meant to bring out the sharp contrast to our own character and its qualities (14 – 19)

- III. We are those who are to “walk in newness of life” but we are inwardly conflicted by a powerful influence to sin. (20 – 21)

IV. Conclusions

- A. First—we are no longer responsible to obey the OT law but it has value to show us we are utterly incapable of attaining righteousness on our own.
- B. Second, verse 14 points this out more clearly—the Law is something which comes from God’s Holy Spirit—it is “spiritual”—and we are not.
- C. Third, when we sin, we cannot blame anyone but ourselves
- D. Fourth, although there is a powerful “principle” of sin at work in us (20 – 21), the fact that we “want to do good” shows that God is also at work in us also.
