The Foundation of Eternal Security John 10:22-31

John 10 reports the final public dialogs with the Jews and the reason for the rising tension over Jesus claims that He is God. In the midst of this tension Jesus goes into great detail - before His enemies - what it means to be one of His sheep. This is one of the most important passages declaring the everlasting love of God toward redeemed sinners and the eternal security of the believer. Jesus describes it in many ways, but we find that it's foundation is in the essence of the Godhead itself.
