***Message.*** Forgiveness of sins.

**Daniel 9:9** “To the Lord our God belong compassion and forgiveness, for we have rebelled against Him;

Acts 10:43; 16:31 The apostles did not take on the forgiving of sins.

Luke 24:33 More than the apostles were present.
