Transitions in Praise Ezra 3

Introduction

Jake's birthday: trainers, toy truck, college fund. It's not what I'll get.

As we transition through life, needs & understanding change.

It is as true in the history of worship as God reveals Himself.

I. God has revealed Himself to you progressively. /[1 Peter 1:10-12]

- A. God has brought you beyond what those in other eras have known.
 - 1. The old days are enticing, but God has given you more. [12-13]
 - 2. God gave pictures to those under age.
 - 3. Receive the fulfillment of the pictures.
- B. Be alert to the progression from creation through the kings.
 - 1. In the garden they enjoyed unhindered fellowship with God.
 - 2. After the fall they needed a sacrifice. [Gen. 4:3-4; 8:20; Job 1:5]
 - 3. In the patriarchal period, altars were only in the Promised Land.
 - 4. Moses: burnt offering was regulated trumpets.
 - 5. David, more instruments & songs of praise.

II. Worship God by the measure of revelation He has given you.

- A. The written Word of God is your guide.
 - 1. He revealed Himself & His worship through Moses [2,4]
 - 2. He revealed Himself further though David. [10-11, 2 Sam. 23:2-3
- B. Be connected in worship with what has gone before your time.
 - 1. They started in the $2^{n\bar{d}}$ mo. as Solomon had done. [2 Ch. 3:2]
 - 2. They got supplies from Lebanon. [2 Ch. 2:8, 16]
 - 3. 20-year old Levites served. [1 Ch. 23:27 cf. Num 8:24]
 - 4. Their song of praise is the same. [1 Ch. 16:34; 2 Ch. 5:13; 7:3]

III. Jesus Christ has transitioned you into the true worship.

- A. Jesus made the pictures obsolete for your worship.
 - 1. God has given you the reality of worship in Christ. [John 4:24]
 - 2. It would be foolish to use the pictures when the reality is present.
- B. See the reality in Christ.
 - 1. He is the atoning sacrifice. [Lev. 1:4; 1 John 2:2; 4:10] (CALL)
 - 2. Intensify worship in the new covenant Sabbath. [Num. 28:9-10]
 - 3. Bring your offerings of praise w/o the instruments. [Heb. 13:15]
- C. Don't long for the Old Covenant ways of worship.
 - 1. They are pictures, not the reality. We have something better.
 - 2. Let your focus be on Christ and don't let the picture distract you.

Conclusion

We live in the new covenant and must be new covenant Christians.

We have continuity w/ the OC saints' worship, but not full identity.

Worship the Lord in the fullness of His revelation—in the reality.
