A. A _____ from Our Confession of Faith – “The Holy Scripture is the only sufficient, certain, and infallible rule of all saving knowledge, faith, and obedience,¹ although the light of nature, and the works of creation and providence do so far manifest the goodness, wisdom, and power of God, as to leave men inexcusable; yet they are not sufficient to give that knowledge of God and His will which is necessary unto salvation.² Therefore it pleased the Lord at sundry times and in diversified manners to reveal Himself, and to declare (that) His will unto His church;³ and afterward **for the better preserving and propagating of the truth,** and for the more sure establishment and comfort of the church against the corruption of the flesh, and the malice of Satan, and of the world, **to commit the same wholly unto writing; which makes the Holy Scriptures to be most necessary,** those former ways of God's revealing His will unto His people being now completed.⁴”
