





#1: Alpha & Omega Highlights the Sovereignty of God


The question of the sovereignty of God is essential to all Christians but especially to those who are going through hard times.

- A “merism” states polar opposites in order to highlight everything between the opposites


“Who hath wrought and done it,

#2: Alpha & Omega Highlights the Eternality of God

The analogy of a river to explain God's eternity:

1. We who are in the river, are only at one place at any not time, and can only see a short distance behind and ahead
2. But God has an aerial view that enables him to see the entire river at once. He knows every turn, sees every narrows, and forces every difficulty and danger

#3: Alpha & Omega Highlights the Autonomy of God



#3: Alpha & Omega Highlights the Autonomy of God



#4: Alpha & Omega Highlights the Immutability of God


- A. God's character does not change
