God Builds Walls Part 2 “Zero Tolerance!”

**I Text:**

Old Covenant: *Genesis 3:21-24*

New Covenant: *Romans 5:12-14*

**II Doctrine:** The merciful God who loves us will not tolerate sin. He will always create a wall of separation between himself and covenant breakers. God will maintain this separation from covenant breakers throughout history. The living God expresses this principle in the Old and New Testament. Our great God will separate himself from the unregenerate for all eternity. You must bow before Jesus Christ as Lord or be lost forever, this is the Father’s zero tolerance policy.

**III Comparing Scripture With Scripture:**

1) The merciful God who loves us will not tolerate sin. He will always create a wall of separation between himself and covenant breakers. (*Genesis 3:21-24; Romans 5:12-14*)

2) God will maintain this separation from covenant breakers throughout history. The living God expresses this principle in the Old and New Testament. (*John 9:24-34; Isaiah 1:10-15*)

3) Our great God will separate himself from the unregenerate for all eternity. You must bow before Jesus Christ as Lord or be lost forever, this is the Father’s zero tolerance policy. (*Daniel 7:9-14; Matthew 26:57-66; Revelation 7:9-17*)

*8But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, [even] in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; 9That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 11For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. 12For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. 13For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. **Romans 10:8-13***

*Definition of zero tolerance*

*: a policy of giving the most severe punishment possible to every person who commits a crime or breaks a rule*

*The police announced that there will be zero tolerance for looters.*

*The camp has a zero tolerance drug and alcohol policy.*
