70. Who Has Believed? – Isaiah 53:1

Isaiah 53 in the New Testament.

- I. Who Has Believed? – Isa. 53:1
  - A. No One – Psa. 14:1-3; Matt. 16:15-17; 1 Cor. 2:9-11
  - B. Revelation is Required – John 8:31-32; John 3:3; 6:63
- II. They Did Not Believe – John 12:37-41
  - A. Did Not – John 3:18-19; 8:45-47; 10:25-27
  - B. Could Not – Isa. 6:10; 28:9-10
    1. Total Inability
      - a. Outer – hear, see
      - b. Inner – understand (discern), know (perceive)
    2. If hearers are resistant to the truth, tell it to them again, clearly and simply
    3. The Lord open eyes and ears, or closes them – Exodus 4:11, 21; Isa. 29:18; 42:18; Matt. 15:31; Rom. 11:7
- III. How Shall They Believe? – Rom. 10:8-17
  - A. Does Faith Come from the Heart? – Jer. 17:9; Matt. 15:19-20
  - B. Does Faith Come from the Mind? – Rom. 8:5, 7; Titus 1:15
  - C. Does Faith Come from the Spirit? – Rom. 5:12; Eph. 2:1-3; 2 Cor. 3:5
  - D. Does Faith Come from the Emotions? – Eph. 4:17-19
  - E. Does Faith Come from Others? – John 1:12-13; Rom. 9:6-8; 1 Cor. 15:50
  - F. Faith Comes by Hearing the Word of God – Rom. 10:17
    1. The Power of the Word – Isa. 55:10-11
    2. The Preaching the Word – 1 Cor. 1:18-21
