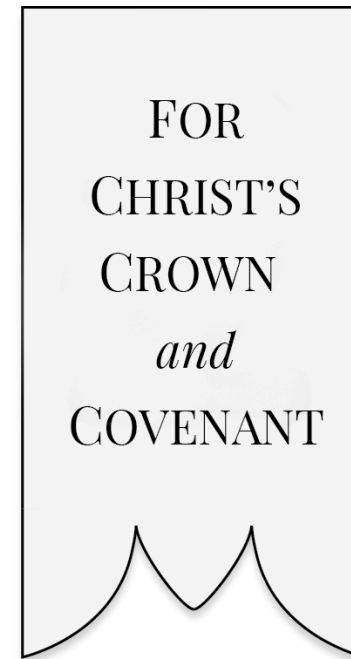

CONFESSON OF FAITH XXIX. *Of the Lord's Supper*
