Introduction

- 1. What stands out in the text is the contrast between the home of the wicked and the home of the just and God's attitude toward each
- 2. The text is a beautiful word of comfort for us in our covenant homes.

The Contrasted People

- 1. Jehovah's blessing is not for the house of the wicked, but is only for the house of the just.
 - a. What is the house of the wicked?
 - b. What is the habitation of the just?
- 2. As the text differentiates between these two houses, it emphasizes what the Christian home should be because of God's sovereign grace.

The Contrasted Attitude...all people of the world are either under God's curse or blessing

- 1. Upon the house of the wicked is the curse of the Lord. What is the curse of the Lord?
- 2. But Jehovah blesses the righteous. What is this blessing?

The Contrasting Result

- 1. The house of the wicked crumbles and falls into everlasting damnation.
- 2. But for the righteous there is eternal life.
