

Great Themes in Isaiah

"The Holiness of God"

Isaiah 6:1-8

Introduction:

I. We need to see **GOD** for Who He is (v.1-4) *(Isaiah sees God for Who He is)*

1) He is a God of **Majestic Holiness** (v.1)

- a) He is an eternal King
- b) He is an exalted King

2) He is a God of **Moral Holiness** (v.2-4)

- a) The seraphim's eyes are not worthy to see
- b) The seraphim's feet are not worthy to serve

II. We need to see **OURSELVES** as we really are (v.5-7) *(Isaiah sees Himself for who he is)*

1) God's holiness reveals an accurate perspective of self (v.5)

2) God's holiness requires an atoning provision for sin (v.6-7)

III. We need to be **CLEAN** before we can serve God acceptably (v.8) *(Isaiah is now ready and willing to serve God)*
