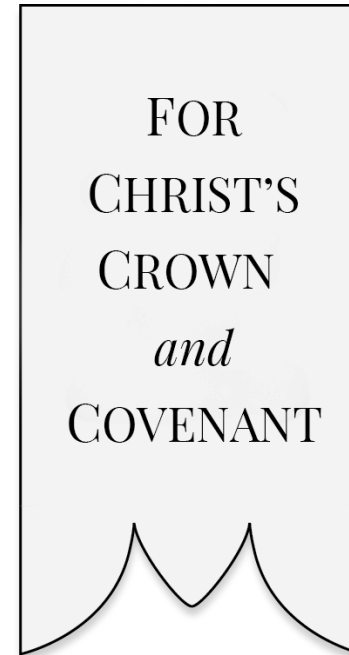

CONFESSION OF FAITH XI. *Of justification*

CONFESSION OF FAITH XV. *Of Repentance unto Life*
