- 1. Christian, God is now your Father, so live like him—imitate him (verses 13–16).
- Christian, your Father is the Judge of every person, so live with a healthy fear of him (verses 17–20).
- 3. <u>Christian, since God is now your Father, other</u> <u>Christians are now your brothers and sisters;</u> <u>live with love for them</u> (verses 22–25).
