Who is Worthy to Open the Scroll? Rev. 5:1-5

Introduction

Chapters 4-5 create a unit, a scene in the throne room of the heavenly Temple.

Review of Chapter 4: The glorious vision of worship.

We move into chapter 5 and eruption of praise slows and the focus narrows. Note: the scene slows down, there is now drama in the throne room. Why?

Truth not only informs the mind, it moves the heart.

- Scripture moves the heart
- Singing moves the heart
- Preaching moves the heart

As we come to Rev. 5, the drama builds to not just give us a proposition: there is One who is worthy, but to raise the affections with His worth!

- I. The Momentous Question: Who is Worthy? (5:1-2)
 - A. The One sitting on the throne has a *biblion* in his right hand
 - B. Written on the front and back
 - C. Sealed with seven seals
 - D. A mighty angel announces with a loud voice:Who is worthy to open the *biblion* and break the seven seals?

 - B. John was weeping

 Because no one was found worthy to open the *biblion* and look at it
- III. The Glorious Answer (5:5)
 - A. One of the elders says to me: Stop weeping

 - C. Conquered the Lion of the tribe of Judah
 - D. And the root of David
 - E. To open the *biblion* and its seven seals
- IV. The Worthy Lamb Takes the Scroll (5:6-7)
- V. Worthy is the Lamb! (5:8-14)
