Why is the resurrection of Jesus so important?

**We were condemned in the sin of Adam;
We are saved through the life of Christ.**

Dead in Adam

One man's trespass brought death for all.

Weak (6) ... Sinners (8) ... Enemies [of God] (10)

...Sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned... even over those whose sinning was not like the transgression of Adam, who was a type of the one who was to come.

Romans 5:12-14



Objections

Alive in Christ

One man's righteousness brought life.

Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men. For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous. Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, so that, as sin reigned in death, grace also might reign through righteousness leading to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
