God is My Salvation – Isaiah

75. Rise Again – Isa. 53:10; John 11:23-27

- I. He Will Rise Again – Isa. 53:10; Matt. 20:18-19
  - A. “He shall prolong His days”
    - 1. “The Lord willed/was pleased to bring Him to weakness (suffering) by crushing Him”
    - 2. A sacrifice for sin
    - 3. “He shall see His seed” – gathering the scattered family for whom reparation was made, one by one
    - 4. From shameful death to glorious splendor – His days restored and prolonged – resurrection and everlasting life
    - 5. The pleasure (will/desire) of the Lord will succeed – He will finish what He started – John 6:39-30; Phil. 1:6; Heb. 12:2
  - B. “The third day He will rise again” – Matt. 16:21; 27:64; Mark 9:31; 10:34; Luke 9:22
- II. He Did Rise Again – Matt. 28:1-7; Luke 24:1-7
  - A. “He is not here; for He is risen, as He said”
  - B. “Remember how He spoke to you?”
  - C. Seen by Witnesses – 1 Cor. 15:3-8, 13-20
- III. We Will Rise Again – John 11:23-27; Isa. 26:18-19
  - A. Resurrection and Life
    - 1. “Though he may die, he will live”
    - 2. “Do you believe this?”
  - B. Raised to New Life – Rom. 6:4-9
    - 1. No longer slaves of sin
    - 2. Death has no more dominion, sting, or power
  - C. Raised by His Power, Presented Together – 1 Cor. 6:14; 2 Cor. 4:14
  - D. Raised in Incorruption -1 Cor. 15:42
  - E. Raised to Live Again, Forever – Isa. 26:18-19
    - 1. When we try to save ourselves the labor is futile
    - 2. Where we fail, God succeeds
    - 3. Awake and sing! – No death, no sorrow, no sickness, no suffering, no sin! – 1 Cor. 15:54-58

Because He lives, I can face tomorrow! Because He lives all fear is gone! Because I know He holds the future. And life is worth the living just because He lives!
