- 2. After Jesus died, why did his followers struggle to believe that he rose from the dead? Why do people today doubt that Jesus literally rose from the dead?
- 3. For Jesus' followers to understand that he would suffer and rise from the dead, what had to first happen to them? (*cf. Lk 24:45-46*) What does this mean?
- 4. Why were the gospel accounts (esp. the gospel according to John) written, as stated in Jn 20:30-31? (see bottom of pg. 3)
- 5. Why is it essential that a person put faith in the person and work of the Lord Jesus Christ, as stated in Jn 3:36? (see bottom of pg. 3)

Christ is risen!

And He [Jesus] began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again. And He was stating the matter plainly. (Mk 8:31-32)

For He [Jesus] was teaching His disciples and telling them, "The Son of Man is to be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill Him; and when He has been killed, He will rise three days later. (Mk 9:31)

Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be delivered to the chief priests and the scribes; and they will condemn Him to death and will hand Him over to the Gentiles. They will mock Him and spit on Him, and scourge Him and kill Him, and three days later He will rise again. (Mk 10:33-34)

He is risen indeed!
