Westminster Confession of Faith 19.6 (The Law of God)

Although true believers be not under the law, as a covenant of works, to be thereby justified, or condemned;^a yet is it of great use to them, as well as to others; in that, as a rule of life informing them of the will of God, and their duty, it directs and binds them to walk accordingly;^b discovering also the sinful pollutions of their nature, hearts, and lives;^c so as, examining themselves thereby, they may come to further conviction of, humiliation for, and hatred against sin,^d together with a clearer sight of the need they have of Christ, and the perfection of His obedience.^e It is likewise of use to the regenerate, to restrain their corruptions, in that it forbids sin:^f and the threatenings of it serve to show what even their sins deserve; and what afflictions, in this life, they may expect for them, although freed from the curse thereof threatened in the law.^g The promises of it, in like manner, shew them God's approbation of obedience, and what blessings they may expect upon the performance thereof:^h although not as due to them by the law as a covenant of works.ⁱ So as, a man's doing good, and refraining from evil, because the law encourageth to the one and deterreth from the other, is no evidence of his being under the law; and not under grace.^j
