Objections Answered

Two main reasons people don't want to hear and will not accept the Gospel...

- 1) They don't think they need it
- 2) They have objections to the Gospel
- 1 Peter 3:15 "always be ready..."

Objection # 1 - Can God be Trusted? - v. 1-4

a) What Advantage has the Jew? - v. 1

v. 2 – Great in every respect!

Paul picks this question up in $9:4-5 \rightarrow 11:25-29$

b) But what about the Individual Jew? - v. 3

Literally "God must be true (covenant-keeper), and every man a liar (covenant-breaker)."

Ps 51 (v. 4) You are justified when you speak, and blameless when you judge me.

You are the faithful Covenant-Keeper, I am the faithless covenant-breaker.

Objection #2 - Is God Just in Judgment? - v. 5-6

Paul answers – How then will God judge the world?

Objection #3 - Your Gospel Encourages Sin! - v. 7-8

First: Saying we teach that, is simply false.

Second: I agree that such teaching is condemned.

Main Take-Away's

- 1) Welcome Objections to the Gospel
- 2) Handle each Objection Differently

And how to answer each question?

- a. Know well the Gospel
- b. Listen well to the question
- c. Pray for wisdom and grace in that moment
- d. Be humble enough to admit when you don't have an answer, but will get back with them.

3) Rejoice in the Simplicity of God's Gospel Plan
