

Feast of Passover & Unleavened Bread (Ex 12:1-28 & Lev 23:4-8)

- Studied first 8 chapters in Leviticus regarding the offerings & sacrifices
- Feasts & festivals, like the offerings, are a picture of the Lord Jesus Christ
- Leviticus 23 is a catalogue of the 7 feasts – other texts to fill out details
 - Seven Feasts and Festivals Recorded in Leviticus 23
 1. 14th day of the first month – Passover
 2. 15th day, next day – Feast of Unleavened Bread for the whole week
 3. 16th day of the first month was the Feasts of First Fruits
 4. Seven weeks later – end of May was Pentecost
 5. 1st day of the seventh month the Feast of Trumpets
 6. 10th day of the seventh month – Great Day of Atonement
 7. 15th day of the seventh month Feast of Tabernacles

 - C) Lamb eaten in haste, Staff in hand, Robe tucked in
 - D) The Feast of Unleavened Bread- turning & fleeing from sin
