Main Point: Phoebe serves as an example of a willing and generous servant in the early church.

I. Phoebe, the Willing Servant of the Church - 16:1.

II. Phoebe, the Generous Servant of the Church - 16:2-3.

See Philippians 3:3-5

Application

- 1) Women and men are equally valuable to the mission and health of the church!

- 2) Women are not less valuable if they do not hold ordained office.

- 3) Both men and women should seek to embrace and excel in the roles assigned by God.

- 4) Warning. If we lose the God-ordained differences between man and woman, we dishonor God, and we lose the gospel purpose of marriage!
