Paul Arrested During Chaos

Acts 21:33-34 (NASB)

Then the commander came up and took hold of him, and ordered him to be bound with two chains; and he began asking who he was and what he had done. But among the crowd some were shouting one thing and some another, and when he could not find out the facts because of the uproar, he ordered him to be brought into the barracks.

• The commander cared about the facts, the mob did not!

Roman Soldiers Rescue Paul Acts 21:35-36 (NASB)

When he got to the stairs, he was carried by the soldiers because of the violence of the mob; for the multitude of the people kept following them, shouting, "Away with him!"

- The commander will become an important person in this narrative
- He will give Paul permission to speak to the Jewish crowd (22:1-17)
- Acts will end with Paul speaking to Jews about Messianic salvation (28:23-28)

The Commander Cares About Facts Acts 21:37-38 (NASB)

As Paul was about to be brought into the barracks, he said to the commander, "May I say something to you?" And he said, "Do you know Greek? Then you are not the Egyptian who some time ago stirred up a revolt and led the four thousand men of the Assassins out into the wilderness?"

- Schnabel links this to an account of Josephus about a prior revolt
- It is soon clear that Paul is part of no such revolt

The Commander Grants Paul a Hearing Before the Jews

Acts 21:39-40 (NASB)

But Paul said, "I am a Jew of Tarsus in Cilicia, a citizen of no insignificant city; and I beg you, allow me to speak to the people." When he had given him permission, Paul, standing on the stairs, motioned to the people with his hand; and when there was a great hush, he spoke to them in the Hebrew dialect, saying,
