I. Worship required a priest set apart by beauty and glory (1-5, 36-43).

"bring near to you Aaron your brother, and his sons with him ... to serve me as priests."

"make holy garments ... for glory and beauty"

"make a plate of pure gold and engrave ... "Holy to the LORD.""

"to cover their naked flesh ... lest they bear guilt and die"

Exodus 20:25-26 Psalm 110 Hebrews 7 Revelation 1:12-16

"Set-apart clothes reflect the set-apart nature, or status, of the priesthood."

II. Worship required a priest to carry the tribes into God's presence (9-12).

"take two onyx stones and engrave on them the names of the sons of Israel"

"settings of gold filigree ... on the shoulder pieces of the ephod"

"Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD ... for remembrance"

Isaiah 49:14-16 John 10:14-18 Revelation 2:17

III. Worship requires a priest to bear their guilt in God's presence (29-30, 33-35).

"make a breastpiece of judgment ... set in it four rows of stones"

"shall bear the names of the sons of Israel ... to bring them to regular remembrance"

"shall bear the judgment of the people ... on his heart".

"so that he does not die"

Ezekiel 28:13 Hebrews 5:7-10
