Weekly Bible Verses

“And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt. . . . And he spake three thousand proverbs: and his songs were a thousand and five. . . . The Meanings Of “Keep”

The word for “keep” is PHULLASSO. It means

“To keep guard over, to watch, to have an eye upon, to guard a person, to keep one from being snatched away, to reserve safe.”

That's what our eternal life is. We don't have eternal life one day, and then we lose it.

Hold Fast Sound Words

The word for “hold fast” is ECHO, which implies that Pastor Timothy is to take hold of the “sound words” and hold them fast. “Sound words” are “healthy” words. “Sound words” are Words that are in the Scripture. These are Words that God has given to us in the Bible. Paul was telling Timothy to “hold fast” these Words.
