Sermon Outline

The Cry of the Martyrs Answered

Rev 6:9-17

I. Intro: The cry of the righteous throughout the ages

II. Exposition:

A. The cry of the martyrs (vv.9-11)

- How long, “O Sovereign Lord, holy and true”
 - God will deliver His people and vindicate His name (Ps 79:10; Luke 18:7-8)
 - Wait for the blessed hope and rejoice in your blessed condition (v.11)

B. The cry answered (vv.12-17)

- The great day of God’s wrath is coming (Matt 24:29ff; Is 13:6; Heb 12:26)
 - It will be terrifying and none can escape it (vv.15-17)
 - It will come unexpectedly (Matt 24:37ff; 1 Thess 5:2)

III. Application:

1. Christ is the only safe refuge against God’s wrath
2. Christ’s return is a call for us to live and to preach like Noah
3. Christ’s return will be a welcome sight to believers (2 Thess 1:10; 1 Thess 4:17)
