

# Hebrews 12:1-3

**-Hebrews 1:1-4 Jesus IS speaking to us now; He IS the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of His nature; He IS upholding the universe by the word of His power and IS at present seated at the right hand of the Majesty on high.**

**-Hebrews 2:9; 17-18 He is presently crowned with glory and honor AFTER tasting death and He presently comes to our aid in temptation.**

**-Hebrews 4:14-16 Jesus is presently the High Priest who presently sympathizes with our weaknesses and through whom we have confidence RIGHT NOW to draw near to the throne of grace.**

**-Hebrews 6:19-20 He is right now, as our ever-living eternal High Priest after the order of Melchizedek the sure and steadfast anchor for our souls.**

**-Hebrews 8:1-2 He declares we  
have in the present time such a  
High Priest in Christ.**

**-Hebrews 10:12-13 Jesus again  
presently seated at the right  
hand of the throne of God in  
heaven.**

**-Hebrews 10:21 The risen Lord Jesus is right now the Great High Priest over the eternal house of God.**



**-Hebrews 12:14 Our  
anticipation is seeing with our  
eyes the risen Lord Jesus.**

**-Hebrews 13:8 The eternal  
Jesus Christ is the same  
yesterday, today, and forever—  
He is eternal, He is not dead  
but alive.**

**-Hebrews 13:20-21 (ESV) 20 Now may the God of peace who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant, 21 equip you with everything good that you may do his will, working in us that which is pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.**

**-Acts 1 begins with the risen Lord Jesus still on the earth in His resurrected flesh and then He ascends into heaven right before the apostles as they watched.**

**-Acts 9 the risen Lord appears  
to Paul on the road to  
Damascus.**

**-Acts 10 He appears to Peter at  
Joppa.**

**-Acts 18 He appears to Paul  
again at Corinth.**

**-Acts 22-23 to Paul in  
Jerusalem.**



**-Romans 1:1-4 opens with a grand declaration of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.**

**-Romans 6:4-5; 8-11 We are encouraged to walk in newness of life from the knowledge that Jesus was raised from the dead and that we will be united with Him in a resurrection like His.**

**-Romans 7:4 We belong to Him  
who has been raised from the  
dead.**

**-Romans 8:34 The risen Christ  
is interceding for us.**

**-Romans 10:9 (ESV) because,  
if you confess with your mouth  
that Jesus is Lord and believe  
in your heart that God raised  
him from the dead, you will be  
saved.**

**-Romans 14:9 Christ died and lived again in order to be Lord of both the living and the dead.**

**-1 Corinthians 1:8 It is the  
living Lord Jesus that sustains  
us to the end.**

**-1 Corinthians 6:14 The  
indwelling living Lord Jesus is  
our reason for abstaining from  
sexual immorality.**



**-1 Corinthians 9:1 Paul testifies  
to seeing the risen Lord Jesus.**

**-1 Corinthians 11:26 We  
celebrate the Lord's Supper  
remembering what He did  
while we anticipate His return.**

**-1 Corinthians 15 The  
quintessential argument from  
Scripture of the absolute  
necessity of the reality of the  
resurrection for our faith and  
our very lives.**

**-2 Corinthians 1:9 We rely  
presently upon God on the  
basis of the reality of the  
resurrection.**

**-2 Corinthians 4:14 Because of His resurrection, we can endure with assurance.**

**-2 Corinthians 5:1-10 We are motivated to holy living because of the knowledge that we will all appear before the risen Lord Jesus.**

**-2 Corinthians 12:9 The risen Lord Jesus tells Paul no regarding his request to remove the thorn in his flesh.**

**-2 Corinthians 13:4 Christ is testified again to have been crucified yet now living by the power of God.**



**-Galatians 1:1 Jesus Christ  
raised from the dead calls Paul  
to be an apostle.**

**-Ephesians 1:20-21 Christ, having been raised from the dead, is seated at the right hand of the Father above all rule, authority, power and dominion.**

**-Ephesians 5:25-27 Christ dies  
and lives again to later present  
to Himself the church.**

**-Philippians 1:6; 9-10 The sights of the church are to be set on the future day of the living Lord Jesus Christ.**

**-Philippians 1:23 Paul's  
consuming desire is to be with  
the living Lord Jesus Christ.**

**-Philippians 2:9-10 The crucified and resurrected Lord Jesus is seen as exalted on high.**

**-Philippians 2:16 Paul speaks  
of the future Day of Christ.**

**-Philippians 3:7-11 Paul rejects  
all the world's goods for the  
sake of the resurrection of  
Christ from the dead.**



**-Philippians 3:20-21 We wait  
for the living Lord Jesus Christ  
to transform our lowly bodies  
to be like His.**

**-Philippians 4:5-6 We live in the  
imminence of His return.**

**-Colossians 1:15-20 He IS!—  
not that He was! He IS God—  
therefore he is the LIVING God!**

**-Colossians 2:9-10 The fullness of deity presently and always dwells in Him and He is RIGHT NOW the Head of all rule and authority.**

**-Colossians 2:12 We who are  
in Christ have been raised  
from spiritual deadness as  
Christ was raised from  
physical death.**

**-Colossians 3:1-4 Christ is raised and seated in heaven and so us with Him will return with Him in glory.**

**-1 Thessalonians 1:9-10 The risen Lord Jesus will return.**

**-1 Thessalonians 3:12-13 Paul speaks of the anticipation of the coming of the risen Lord Jesus with all His saints.**



**-1Thessalonians 4:13-5:11 The risen Christ will return and will also bring His wrath upon all who have disobeyed His Gospel.**

**-2 Thessalonians 1:5-2:12 The  
resurrected Lord Jesus returns  
to the earth with vengeance on  
His docket.**

**-1 Timothy 1:1 Paul is an  
apostle by the command of the  
living Lord Jesus.**

**-1 Timothy 1:12 The living Lord  
is the activator of Paul's  
service.**

**-1 Timothy 1:17 Christ is said  
to be the King of ages,  
immortal, invisible, the only  
God.**

**-1 Timothy 3:16 Paul speaks of  
Christ taken up into glory after  
His resurrection.**

**-1 Timothy 5:21 Paul charges Timothy in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus.**

**-1 Timothy 6:13 Paul charges Timothy again in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus.**



**-1 Timothy 6:14-16 Here is the anticipation again of the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

**-2 Timothy 1:10 Our Savior  
Christ Jesus abolished death  
and brought life and  
immortality to light through the  
Gospel.**

**-2 Timothy 2:8 Jesus Christ,  
risen from the dead.**

**-2 Timothy 4:1 Paul charges Timothy again in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus.**

**-2 Timothy 4:8 Anticipating  
reward from the Lord on the  
Day of Judgment.**

**-Titus 2:13 Waiting for our  
blessed hope, the appearing of  
the glory of our great God and  
Savior Jesus Christ.**

**-Philemon 1 & 9 The living  
Lord Jesus personally  
imposes Paul's imprisonment  
upon him.**

**-James 5:7 We are encouraged  
to be patient waiting on the  
coming of the Lord.**



**-1 Peter 1:3 We are born again  
to a living hope through the  
resurrection of the Lord Jesus  
Christ from the dead.**

**-1 Peter 1:13 Jesus Christ to be revealed at His return.**

**-1 Peter 1:21 Jesus declared to  
be raised from the dead by  
God.**

**-1 Peter 3:18-22 Christ crucified judges spirits and is at the right hand of God with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to Him.**

**-1 Peter 4:13 We will rejoice with gladness when His glory is revealed in His return.**

**-1 Peter 5:4 The Chief Shepherd, Jesus Christ, will appear and give us an unfailing crown of glory.**

**-2 Peter 3:1-14 The Day of the Lord will come so prioritize godliness accordingly!**

**-1 John 1:3 Present fellowship  
with a living Christ  
presupposes a past  
resurrection.**



**-1 John 2:1 The risen Jesus Christ presently advocates for those who are His own before the Father.**

**-1 John 2:28 The Lord is  
returning so live so as not to  
be ashamed.**

**-1 John 5:5 The one believing  
Jesus IS the Son of God is the  
one conquering the world.**

**-2 John 3 Grace, mercy, and  
peace WILL BE with us from  
the Father and from the Son.**

**-Jude 1 The called are BEING  
KEPT by Jesus Christ.**

**-Jude 4 Jesus functions  
presently as the ONLY Master  
and Lord.**

**-Jude 24-25 Jesus Christ is able now and forevermore to keep us from stumbling and present us blameless before the presence of His glory.**

**-No resurrection = No Gospel**



**-1 Corinthians 15:1-8 (ESV) 1 Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, 2 and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you--unless you believed in vain. 3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, 5 and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. 6 Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep. 7 Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles. 8 Last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to me.**

**-No resurrection, no Gospel.  
No Gospel, no hope.**

**-Christ is risen, He is risen  
indeed.**
