

Seeking the Lord and the Means of Grace

1. God's priority for all men and women is to seek Him (Acts 17:26-27a).
2. Perhaps, some say, God's purpose does not apply after the fall (Acts 27b, Rom. 3:9-11).
3. However, God does not foreclose all hope in seeking Him (Acts 17:27-28, 22-25).
4. Calling people to seek the Lord is a Biblical way of doing evangelism (Isa. 55:6-9).
5. When the Holy Spirit convicts men and women and prompts them to seek the Lord, you and I should encourage them to do so (John 16:8-9).
6. When God's Providence provokes people to seek the Lord, you and I should encourage them to do so (Ps. 83:13-18).
7. You should encourage people to seek the Lord using the means of grace.
8. The church assembled for corporate worship is a primary means of evangelism and God's chief means to draw sinners to Himself (Ps. 87:1-3).
